Procedure

Explanation

The use of **non-motorized** bicycles, skateboards, scooters, and in-line skates shall be allowed as a means of transportation on sidewalks, walkways and roadways of The University of Montana. Anyone using one of these methods of travel shall give right of way to any pedestrian and shall travel at a speed no greater than twice that of walking speed. Under no circumstances will the above vehicles be allowed on ramps, curbs, benches, steps or other pieces of buildings or decorations. None of these vehicles are permitted for use inside any building.

Enforcement

A person in violation of this regulation will be asked to stop the activity and/or leave the campus and may be cited for a criminal violation such as **disorderly conduct** (45-8-101) or **criminal mischief** (45-6-101). A second violation or a refusal to leave may subject the violator to a notice of trespass from The University of Montana. Subsequent violations or a return to The University of Montana may result in arrest or notice to appear for **criminal trespass** under the provisions of chapter 45-6-203, Montana Codes Annotated.

If the violator is a current University of Montana student, they will also be subject to punishment under the student conduct code.
