PROCEDURE

Board Policy:

The President of The University of Montana is authorized to enforce rules and regulations concerning the parking and operation of vehicles upon the grounds, streets, drives and alleys of this campus.

The President of The University of Montana is authorized to charge a motor vehicle registration fee or vehicle parking fee, or both, subject to the following procedure.

Fines for violations of campus parking and vehicle regulations may be assessed in amounts from \$10.00 to \$50.00 per offense.

Exception: The fine for parking illegally in a designated parking zone reserved for a person with a disability shall be \$100. 00.

ENFORCEMENT

Rules and Regulations adopted shall be published and a copy of such rules shall be filed with the Commissioner of Higher Education.

The President shall submit to the Board of Regents a request to establish or increase such a fee. The President shall include with the request a description of the procedure by which the campus student governance organization, the faculty and staff were consulted.

The Commissioner, on behalf of the Board, will notify the governing board of the campus student body of the proposed fee, and invite comment on the proposal.

Thereafter, the Board may reject, adopt or modify the proposed fee, provided that any fee so established shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded by the Board.

The monies received from the fee will be used for the development and improvement of parking lots, campus traffic control, and operational costs.

Application: All Faculty, Staff, Students and visitors parking vehicles on campus must abide by the current year published vehicle regulations.
